EASTERN PANHANDLE EXPANSION PROJECT



OVERVIEW

The Eastern Panhandle Expansion project is being developed to support economic growth in the Eastern Panhandle region of West Virginia. Once complete, this new pipeline will provide more than 47 million cubic feet per day of reliable, clean burning natural gas to meet the energy needs of homes and businesses in Morgan County.

PROJECT SCOPE

The Eastern Panhandle Expansion project will construct approximately 3.4 miles (5.4 km) of 8-inch diameter pipeline, commencing at interconnections with Columbia's existing Line 1804 and Line 10240 in Fulton County, Pennsylvania, and extending through Washington County, Maryland, to a point of delivery with the local distribution company, Mountaineer Gas Company, in Morgan County, West Virginia.



ANTICIPATED PROJECT SCHEDULE

TC Energy has worked with FERC and other federal, state and local agencies to acquire the appropriate permits and perform an extensive environmental review of the project area prior to construction starting.
