### ABOUT THE ANR HEARTLAND PROJECT

The ANR Heartland Project (AHP) is designed to help meet growing customer demand and address the evolving utility reliability requirements across TC Energy's ANR pipeline service area. For decades, the ANR Pipeline Company has served as the backbone of the midwestern energy system. Now, AHP will further enhance this system to help meet the natural gas needs of millions of residents and businesses. It will require approximately 70 miles of new and replacement pipeline, modifications to existing compressor stations, installation of new compressor stations and expansion of meter stations across Wisconsin and Illinois. When complete, the AHP will increase capacity by 473,000 Dth/d across multiple existing points of delivery (POD).

### LOCAL CONTRACTING AND SUPPLIER DIVERSITY OPPORTUNITIES

- Since announcing the Heartland Project in March 2024, TC Energy has engaged in conversations with community leaders and residents throughout the region to gather feedback on supplier diversity and local contracting.
- As we continue with the permitting process, TC Energy is exploring all options to ensure that the workforce hired for this project is representative of neighboring communities. This includes pursuing opportunities to hire local vendors, including Indigenous-owned businesses and small, women and minority-owned (SWaM) businesses.
- The AHP will result in a substantial investment in capital and personnel expenses in Wisconsin and Illinois. TC Energy is dedicated to ensuring these investments create lasting benefits for our local workforce and economy.

- Temporary storage facilities
