



# OAK GROVE ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

## Project Fact Sheet

TC Energy is planning to replace approximately 33.6 miles of existing 30” pipeline utilizing parallel lay and abandonment method on ANR Line 0-501 north of the Delhi compressor station in Louisiana. The following modifications in Richland and West Carroll parishes in Louisiana will be performed:

- Installation of a new pipeline parallel to the existing ANR 501 pipelines.
- Service transfer from existing ANR Line 0-501 to newly installed pipeline. The service transfer will be designed to ensure minimal service interruption to the area.
- Upon completion of the service transfer, the abandonment of the existing infrastructure will begin on ANR 0-501 from the Delhi Compressor Station to the ANR 501 main line valve (MLV) station 16, located in West Carroll Parish.

The replacement of the pipeline segment is needed to enhance system reliability, operational safety, and reduce the risk of interruptions to ANR customers due to the age and condition of the existing segment of Line 0-501.

We will be working closely with FERC, the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and other local agencies to acquire the appropriate permits. Construction is anticipated to start as early as Q1 2025 with a proposed in-service date in 2025.

Throughout all stages of the project, we will continue to develop and maintain relationships with landowners and local communities along our footprint as we safely, responsibly deliver the energy people need—every day.
